

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

(U472 BACK LANE, NEWBURGH, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U472 Back Lane, Newburgh from the property named Snape Barn for a distance of 150m in a Westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April 2024 until 1700 hours on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U472 Back Lane, Newburgh – A5209 Course Lane, Newburgh – U472 Back Lane, Newburgh and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow joint bay and electrical connection works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
