

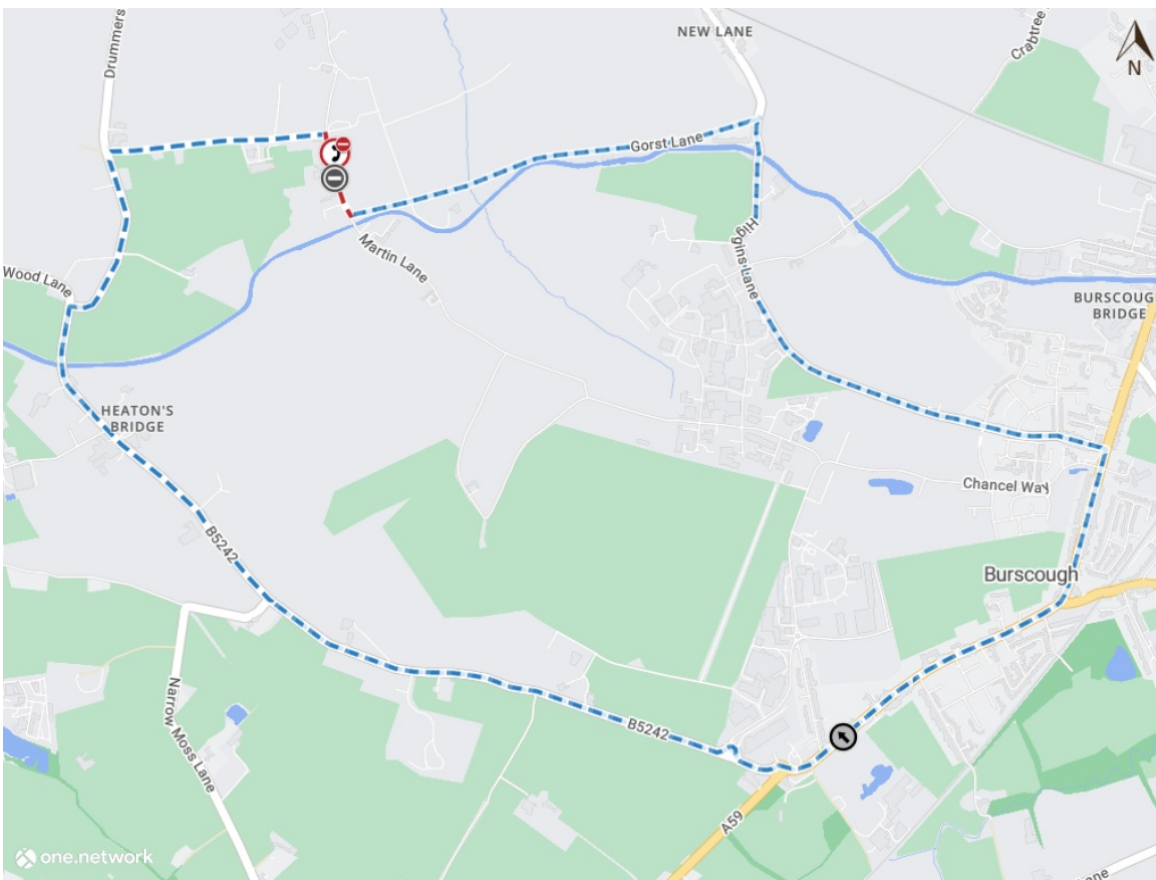

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER YEAR 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Martin Lane, Burscough from Merscar Lane to Gorst Lane. Access will be maintained wherever and whenever possible.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 09:30 hours on 30th April 2024 until 15:00 hours on 30th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:- Merscar Lane, Drummersdale Lane, Heaton's Bridge Road, Barrison Green, Pippin Street, Liverpool Road South, Higgins Lane, New Lane, Gorst Lane and vice versa
