

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(WHEEL LANE, PILLING, WYRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council considers it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Wheel Lane, Pilling from its junction with Smallwood Hey Road travelling in a northerly direction for approximately 20 metres.
2. Nothing in this Notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 14th April 2024 until 2359 hours on 18th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities to carry out urgent repair works to a leaking valve in the carriageway.
