NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BENTINCK ROAD, HIGHBURY ROAD WEST AND TODMORDEN ROAD, LYTHAM ST ANNES, FYLDE BOROUGH) (ONE WAY, MANDATORY CYCLE LANE AND PROHIBITION OF ENTRY) ORDER 202*



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 26 October 2023 and 23 November 2023, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

Insert the wording 'Except Pedal Cycles' into Article 3. Prohibition of Entry so that it reads:

3. Prohibition of Entry Except Pedal Cycles

Save as is hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction of with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any Vehicle, except a Pedal Cycle, to proceed in the length of road referred to in Schedule 2 of this Order.

Statement of Reasons

The no entry restriction is proposed to mitigate redistributed traffic resulting from the one-way proposal. The exemption for cycles was omitted from the original order by mistake and this modification order seeks to correct the order to what was initially intended.
