

**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(LODGE LANE, WENNINGTON, LANCASTER CITY) (REVOCATION)**  
**ORDER 202\***

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Speed Limit Order under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to revoke "The Lancashire County Council (B6480 Wennington Road, Wennington, Hornby Road, Wray and C513 Lodge Lane, Wennington and Melling, Lancaster City) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 1991" insofar as it relates to Item iii) of the Schedule. Where no further speed limit is re-introduced, the speed limit will revert to restricted road status by virtue of street lighting, where a 30mph speed limit will apply.
