(JOHN STREET, NORTHCOTE STREET AND QUIN STREET, LEYLAND, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order. AND FURTHER the County Council are satisfied that these works will take in excess of 18 months to execute

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the borough of South Ribble;
 - i. John Street, Leyland from its junction with Quin Street to its junction with Newsome Street.
 - ii. Northcote Street, Leyland from its junction with B5254 Hough Lane for its entire length.
 - iii. Quin Street, Leyland from B5254 Hough Lane to its junction with John Street.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Saturday 1st April 2023 until 2359 hours on Monday 31st March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Quin Street - B5254 Hough Lane – Newsome Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow demolition and construction of new building works to be carried out South Ribble Borough Council.
