(PARKER LANE, FARINGTON, SOUTH RIBBLE, BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Parker Lane, Farington from it's junction of Chain House Lane for a distance of 100 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours on Sunday 12th May 2024 until 1500 hours on Sunday 12th May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services will be maintained access when required.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not available.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow utility works to be carried out.
