## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(THORNGATE, PENWORTHAM, SOUTH RIBBLE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Thorngate, Penwortham from it's junction with Whitefield Road, Penwortham to it's junction with Manor Lane, Penwortham.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1800 hours on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> May 2024 to Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. The road may be opened earlier each day dependent of works progress at that given time.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services will be maintained access when required.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Whitefield Road - Highfield Avenue - Manor Lane vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow resurfacing works to be carried out.
