HOGARTH AVENUE, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hogarth Avenue, Burnley from outside of number 6 Hogarth Avenue to outside of number 14 Hogarth Avenue.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 18th June 2024 until 1700 hours on Thursday 20th June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Marsden Road – Kings Causeway – Halifax Road – Nelson Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow water connection works to be carried out.
