(KIRKHAM BYPASS, KIRKHAM, FYLDE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Kirkham Bypass, Kirkham at its junctions of the roundabout outside the "Kingfisher" public house.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative **nightly** from 2200 hours to 0500 hours on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2024 until Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular and pedestrian access for residents will be maintained at all times.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Kirkham Bypass – Blackpool Road – Dowbridge – Poulton Street – Station Road – Garstang Road North – Kirkham Wesham Bypass and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by LCC Highways.
