(POULTON STREET, FLEETWOOD, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Poulton Street, Fleetwood from its junction with Blakiston Street to its junction with Harris Street.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1800 hours on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June until Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Blakiston Street – Milton Street – Harris Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by LCC Highways.
