(WESTFIELD AVENUE, STAINING, FYLDE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Westfield Avenue, Staining from its junction with Staining Road to house number 2 Westfield Avenue.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1800 hours on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for motor vehicles will be maintained whenever and wherever possible, and for pedestrians at all times.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Staining Road – Normoss Road – Whitemoss Avenue

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to re-set a manhole frame and cover to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
