NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C161 Higher Lane, Dalton from A5209 Alder Lane, Parbold to the property named Grange Court.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Tuesday 21st May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

C161 Higher Lane, Dalton – U645 Dungeon Lane, Dalton – C163 Lees Lane, Dalton – C163 Lees Lane, Roby Mill – C162 Appley Lane South, Appley Bridge – C162 Appley Lane North, Appley Bridge – B5375 Appley Lane North, Appley Bridge – A5209 Hall Lane, Wrightington – A5209 Sparrow Hill, Parbold – A5209 Parbold Hill, Parbold – A5209 Alder Lane, Parbold and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telegraph pole testing works to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals UK on behalf of BT.
