NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U1025 Malt Kiln Lane, Aughton from C117 Parrs Lane, Aughton to the property named The Coach House.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Wednesday 22nd May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not possible owing to the fact that U1025 Malt Kiln Lane, Aughton is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow civils works to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals on behalf of BT.
