(DRUMACRE LANE EAST, LONGTON, SOUTH RIBBLE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Drumacre Lane East, Longton from the junction of Cottom Lane to Longton Bypass, in a Westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 28th May 2024 until 1700 hours on Friday 7th June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Longton Bypass – Gill Lane – Land Lane – Drumacre Lane East and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow tracking and repair works to be carried out.
