(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Eagleton Way, Penwortham from its junction with The Cawsey for a distance of 22 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2024 until 1530 hours on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not available.
5. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible for residents.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow utility works to be carried out.
