- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Browsholme Avenue, Burnley from its junction with Brownhill Avenue to its junction with Brandwood Grove.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 1400 hours on Thursday 9th May 2024 until 2359 hours on Monday 13th May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent gas main replacement works to be carried out.
