- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0920 hours on Sunday 12th May 2024 until 2359 hours on Thursday 6th May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow immediate works due to loss of gas supply to be carried out by Cadent Gas.
