

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CARRIAGEWAY SURFACE DRESSING SCHEME, RIBBLETON,
PRESTON, PRESTON CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of roads in Ribbleton, Preston in their entirety as follows: -

Grizedale Crescent, Thornley Road, Sawley Crescent, Slaidburn Road, Whitmore Drive, Whitmore Grove, Whitmore Place, Hareden Road, Greenhorn Crescent, Marl Hill Crescent, Parlick Road, Birkett Drive, Birkett Place, Bowland Road, Bowland Place, Hazelhurst Road, Burholme Road, Burholme Place, Burholme Close, Langden Drive, Woodacre Road.

2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily when indicated by signage placed on the highway as set out in the Traffic Signs, Regulations and General Direction from 0800 hours until 1800 hours on 26th June 2024 until 29th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure will be signed locally: -

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out carriageway surface dressing works.
