(LECKONBY STREET & CHESHAM STREET, GREAT ECCLESTON, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Wyre
 - i. Leckonby Street from its junction with South Street to its junction with High Street.
 - ii. Chesham Street from its junction with Leckonby Street for approximately 30 metres in an easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibitions will be operative from 0930 hours to 1530 hours from Wednesday 17th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

High Street – Chapel Street – South Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow fibre overhead cabling works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
