(C124 HALL LANE, SIMONSWOOD, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C124 Hall Lane, Simonswood from X9805 Moss Lane, Simonswood to the property named Grayson's Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0930 hours and 1500 hours from Monday 3rd June 2024 until Friday 7th June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

C124 Hall Lane, Simonswood (into Knowsley Council) – Hall Lane, Knowsley Council – Shevington Lane, Knowsley Council – A506 Bank Lane, Knowsley Council (into Sefton Council) – A506 Bank Lane, Sefton Council – A506 Prescot Road, Sefton Council – A506 Cunscough Lane, Sefton Council (into Lancashire County Council) – A506 Liverpool Road, West of Stanleygate – C124 Simonswood Lane, Bickerstaffe – C124 Hall Lane, Bickerstaffe – C124 Hall Lane, Simonswood and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safe access to underground structures to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals UK on behalf of BT.
