- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Brabiner Lane, Goosnargh from Haighton Green Lane, Haighton to approximately the property named Brabiner Cottage.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0935 hours on Tuesday 14th May 2024 until 2359 hours on Friday 17th May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair works to the collapsing carriageway embankment to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
