NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed in a Southerly direction over that length of Churchill Way, Leyland from Golden Hill Lane, Leyland for an approximate distance of 13m in a Southerly direction.

AND FURTHER, no person shall cause any class of traffic proceeding in an Easterly direction to turn right from Golden Hill Lane, Leyland onto Churchill Way, Leyland

- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1230 hours on Wednesday 15th May 2024 until 2359 hours on Sunday 19th May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow emergency repair works to a gas leak to be carried out by Cadent Gas.
