

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(GOLDEN HILL LANE, LEYLAND, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed in a Westerly direction over that length of Golden Hill Lane, Leyland from the western boundary of property number 26 to Churchill Way, Leyland.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1455 hours on Wednesday 15th May 2024 until 2359 hours on Sunday 19th May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Churchill Way, Leyland – Hough Lane, Leyland – Churchill Way, Leyland

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow emergency repair works to a gas leak to be carried out by Cadent Gas.
