(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of Roads;
 - i. Brookhouse Road, Caton from its junction with Artle Beck Road to the private entrance road to Lane House Farm.
 - ii. Holme Lane, Brookhouse at its junction with A683 Hornby Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 28th May 2024 until 1700 hours on Sunday 2nd June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
 - i. Brookhouse Road; Brookhouse Road – Caton Green Road – A683 Hornby Road – Brookhouse Road.
 - ii. Holme Lane – Access for residents and business will be maintained via Brookhouse Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow trial hole excavation for investigation works to be carried out on behalf of Cadent Gas.
