(ST MICHAELS ROAD, BILSBORROW, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of St Michaels Road, Bilsborrow from the property "The Oaks" for approximately 880 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative <u>overnight</u> from 2100 hours until 0600 hours on Thursday 27th June 2024 until Friday 28th June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Hall Lane – Blackpool Road – Garstang Road – Tarnacre Lane – Garstang Bypass Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow cabling works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
