(ST MICHAELS ROAD, BILSBORROW, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of St Michaels Road, Bilsborrow from the property "The Oaks" for approximately 880 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative **overnight** from 2100 hours until 0600 hours on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2024 until Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Hall Lane – Blackpool Road – Garstang Road – Tarnacre Lane –  
Garstang Bypass Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow cabling works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
