

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(STONEY LANE, ELLEL, LANCASTER CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Stoney Lane, Ellel from outside Pennine Bee Farm for a distance of approximately 150 metres in a south easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Tuesday 30th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Stoney Lane – A6 Main Road – A6 Preston Lancaster Road – Hampson Lane – Stoney Lane and vice versa.
Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever safe passage permits.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telegraph pole test works to be carried out.
