
NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(NORTH PROMENADE, CLEVELEYS, WYRE BOROUGH) (PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a zebra crossing in North promenade, Cleveleys, from a point 7 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Rough Lea Road for a distance of 43 metres in a northerly direction.



Statement of Reasons

Public realm improvements are being made to Cleveleys, which is the most important section of the existing high street area. As part of the scheme, the footways are being widened and the carriageway on Princess Road is being narrowed to allow a public events space and market.

As a result of the above measures, it is proposed to remove an existing splitter island on North Promenade and replace it with a Zebra Crossing in a similar location.
