
NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BROADWAY, HOLME STREET AND SAGAR STREET, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH) (REMOVAL AND INTRODUCTION OF PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed the above under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 01 November 2024 and 29 November 2024, it is now intended to modify the proposal as titled above, as set out below.

To withdraw the proposal to remove the puffin crossing in Sagar Street, Nelson, from a point 15.2 metres west of its roundabout junction with Netherfield Road for a distance of 42.2 metres in a westerly direction.



Statement of Reasons

To maintain the existing pedestrian crossing facilities at this location, thereby reducing the number of pedestrians wishing to cross at the nearby proposed parallel crossing on Sagar Street and hence assisting to maintain traffic flow at the Sagar Street / Broadway / Holme Street mini-roundabout.
