(C103 OLD MOSS LANE, DOWNHOLLAND, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of C103 Old Moss Lane, Downholland from its junction with the Cheshire Lines Path access road to a point 105m North East of the Eastern Side of Mossbridge Station Bridge.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0000 hours on Tuesday 28th January 2025 until 1500 on Saturday 24th January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. No access will be maintained for the duration of the closure owing to the fact that Mossbridge Station Bridge has failed a safety inspection and, as such, is unsafe for use by any class of traffic.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

C103 Moss Side, Downholland (into Sefton Borough) - Moss Side, Sefton Borough – A565 Formby By-Pass, Sefton Borough – B5195 Altcar Road, Sefton Borough (into West Lancashire Borough) – B5195 Lord Sefton Way, Great Altcar – B5195 Broad Lane, Great Altcar – B5195 Causeway Lane, Great Altcar – B5195 Wood Lane, Great Altcar – B5195 Flatmans Lane, Downholland – B5195 Altcar Lane, Downholland - C105 Black-A-Moor Lane, Downholland -U968 Moss Lane, Downholland and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair works to Mossbridge Station Bridge to be carried out.
