ASS140 - NEW Think like a Moderator - Key Stage 2

This brand-new full day course is an opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of the training materials that are produced by STA to support local authority moderators in preparing for their role. The session will ensure that colleagues receive the same messages as moderators and will cover key aspects of working towards the expected standard (WTS), working at the expected standard (EXS) and greater depth standard (GDS).

ASS160 - KS1 Mid-year Moderation Opportunity Supporting Teacher Judgements

From the academic year 2023/2024 schools are no longer required to submit data for children at the end of Key Stage 1 however moderation continues to be identified as best practice and the opportunity to engage in professional discussions with colleagues is invaluable. This half day course allows participants the opportunity to explore standardisation materials, which will support a shared understanding of a standard and then participate in professional discussions about children's work.
