
NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(GOOSNARGH LANE AND HAYMAKER WAY, GOOSNARGH,
PRESTON CITY) (JUNCTION TABLE)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a junction table in the following locations:

- a) Haymaker Way, Goosnargh, Preston, from its junction with the centreline of Goosnargh Lane for a distance of 11 metres in a north easterly direction;
- b) Goosnargh Lane, Goosnargh, Preston, from a point 13.9 metres north west to a point 10.8 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Haymaker Way.

The junction table will have a maximum height not exceeding 75 mm.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of the junction table at the junction on Goosnargh Lane/Haymaker Way are to support and self-police the change in speed limit, in the interest of highway safety for all users and to mitigate against the increase in traffic and pedestrian movements generated by the new housing development.
