#### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BARNYARD WAY, GOOSNARGH LANE, HAYMAKER WAY AND MILL LANE, GOOSNARGH, PRESTON CITY) (REVOCATION AND 20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202\*

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under 83(2) and Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

### 1. Revocation

Those parts of the "Lancashire County Council (Goosnargh Area, Goosnargh and Whittingham (Various Roads), Preston City) (Part Revocation and 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2012", as set out in Schedule 1 to this Order, are hereby revoked.

### 2. 20mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph on any of the lengths of road as set out in Schedule 2 to this Order.

### 3. Exemption

No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.

## 4. <u>Commencement of Order</u>

This Order shall come into force on the \*\* day of \*\* 202\* and shall be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Barnyard Way, Goosnargh Lane, Haymaker Way And Mill Lane, Goosnargh, Preston City) (Revocation And 20mph Speed Limit) Order 202\*".

## Schedule 1 – Revocation

- a) Mill Lane, the entire length.
- b) Goosnargh Lane, from its junction with Mill Lane in a westerly direction to a point 70 metres north west of its centre line with Oakleaf Close.

# Schedule 2 - 20mph Speed Limit

- a) Barnyard Way, Preston, the entire length.
- b) Goosnargh Lane, Goosnargh, from its junction with Mill Lane/Church Lane in a westerly direction to a point 75 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Haymaker Way.
- c) Haymaker Way, Preston, the entire length.
- d) Mill Lane, Preston, from its junction with Church Lane/Goosnargh Lane for a distance of 88 metres in a north easterly direction.
