## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

# (PEAR TREE LANE AND SCHOOL LANE, EUXTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (REVOCATION AND 20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202\*

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under 83(2) and Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

#### 1. Revocation

That part of the "Lancashire County Council (Euxton Central East Area, Euxton (Various Roads) Chorley Borough) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2012", as set out in Schedule 1 to this Order, is hereby revoked.

#### 2. 20mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph on any of the lengths of road as set out in Schedule 2 to this Order.

#### 3. Exemption

No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.

#### 4. Commencement of Order

This Order shall come into force on the \*\* day of \*\* 202\* and shall be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Pear Tree Lane And School Lane, Euxton, Chorley Borough) (Revocation And 20mph Speed Limit) Order 202\*".

## Schedule 1 - Revocation

The Schedule – 20mph Speed Limit. School Lane, Euxton, from a point 18 metres east of the centre line of its junction with Orchard Close to its junction with A6 Wigan Road.

### Schedule 2 - 20mph Speed Limit

- a) Pear Tree Lane, Euxton, from a point 15 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Euxton Lane to a point 21 metres south of its junction with the centreline of School Lane.
- b) School Lane, Euxton, the entire length.
