NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bengal Street, Chorley (Northbound carriageway only) from its junction with Hollinshead Street for a distance of 30 metres in a northerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 09:00 hours until 15:00 on Sunday 27th April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible**
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: UNION STREET, PARK ROAD, COMMERCIAL ROAD

The temporary prohibition is necessary frame and cover replacement works to be carried out.
