NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:

- a) Copp Lane, Elswick, the west side, from a point 13.5 metres south of its junction with the projected centreline of Highbury Gate for a distance of 27 metres in a southerly direction;
- b) Copp Lane, Elswick, the east side, from a point 23 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Larch Lane for a distance of 27 metres in a southerly direction;
- c) Copp Lane, Great Eccleston, the north west side, from a point 39 metres south west of its junction with the projected centreline of Admarsh Drive for a distance of 11 metres in a south westerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

These proposals are being pursued as part of a Section 278 agreement under the Highways Act 1980. The proposals are being funded fully by the developer and are linked to the new housing development for 345 new dwellings and the associated planning conditions.

The purpose of the Bus Stops clearways are to support the upgrade of the existing bus stops to quality bus stops. This is to allow the buses to pull in and out safely and allow for effective enforcement. A raised boarding platform will also be installed to ensure safe boarding and alighting of mobility impaired passengers and ensure the bus stops are fully mobility compliant.
