REAR 2 TO 30 BOUNDARY STREET, BURNLEY BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rear 2 to 30 Boundary Street, Burnley from outside number 8 for 10 metres in either direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2025 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Briercliffe Road - St Cuthbert Street - Bulcock Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow installation of a new water connection to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
