

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(PRESTON ROAD, WHITTLE-LE-WOODS, CHORLEY
BOROUGH) (BUS STOP CLEARWAY)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in Preston Road, Whittle-le-Woods, the west side, from a point 15 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Foxglove Drive for a distance of 21 metres in a northerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of the proposed Bus Stop Clearway is to facilitate the safe passage of vehicles and pedestrians, providing Equality Act (2010) compliant bus stops.

Buses cannot safely access a suitable boarding point at the existing shelter position and subsequently obstruct traffic.

A wider footway and a relocated bus shelter is to be offered at the existing layby on the west side of Preston Road and the introduction of a Bus Stop Clearway will prevent parked vehicles from obstructing kerbside boarding / alighting and improve bus journey times and consistency.
