(BACK LANE AND STUMP HALL ROAD, HIGHAM, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Back Lane and Stump Hall Road, Higham as follows: -

Back Lane - from its junction with Stump Hall Road travelling south easterly to a point outside number 19.

Stump Hall Road – from its junction with Guide Lane to its junction with Back Lane.

- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0600 hours until 1800 hours on 12th May 2025 until 9th June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Higham Hall Road - Barrowford Road - Guide Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out surface dressing in the carriageway.
