(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Blackburn Road and Ribblesdale Road, Ribchester from a point outside 38 Blackburn Road to a point outside 2 Ribblesdale Road, Ribchester.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1500 hours on 27th April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
- Clitheroe Road Green Moor Lane Ribchester Road
- Ribchester Road Blackburn Road Lower Lane Chapel Hill Preston Road – Longridge Road – Ribbleton Avenue – Blackpool Road – New Hall Lane – Brockholes Brow – Preston New Road – Whalley Road – Myerscough Smithy Road – Longsight Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities to reset a chamber frame and cover in the carriageway.
