NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Ascot Way, Accrington from number 9 Ascot Way for a distance of 20 metres in a northerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 9th June 2025 to 1700 hours on to Monday 16th June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Overnight closures only)> Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic (except HGVs) affected by the closure is via:- Sandy Lane Ascot Way and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation for 32m of track in the carriageway to install and joint cable for new connection undertaken by Network Plus.
