SUTTON AVENUE TARLETON, WEST LANCS BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Sutton Avenue, Tarleton from Outside Douglas House in a north easterly Direction for a distance of 40 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1800 hours from Tuesday 29th April 2025 to Monday 5th May2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. The probation will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 4. No diversion required being a cul-de-sac.
- 5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 6. Residents access will be maintained to park overnight

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out on behalf of Lancashire County Council
