TONG LANE, BACUP, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Rossendale;
 - i. Tong Lane from its junction with Thornbank to the junction of Pennine Road.
 - ii. Tong Lane from its junction with South Street to its junction with Thornbank.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. **Works are weather dependent and may not be carried out on the dates specified.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Pennine Road – Rochdale Road – St James Street – Yorkshire Street – Tong Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council
