

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

(GRANGE LANE, STALMINE – WITH - STAYNALL, WYRE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of grange Lane, Stalmine – With - Staynall from outside Grange Farm Caravan Park to outside Grange Gardens.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained at all times. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Back Lane – Cemetery Lane – Hall Gate Lane – Smithy Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out.
