(GRANGE LANE, STALMINE – WITH - STAYNALL, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of grange Lane, Stalmine With Staynall from outside Grange Farm Caravan Park to outside Grange Gardens.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained at all times. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Back Lane – Cemetery Lane – Hall Gate Lane – Smithy Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out.
