(REAR 1 TO 73 BERRIEDALE ROAD, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rear 1 To 73 Berriedale Road, Nelson from a point at the rear of number 60 Berriedale Road travelling in either direction for approximately 10 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 2nd June 2025 until 1700 hours on 4th June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Dundonnell Road – Berriedale Road – Lynthorpe Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities to install a new customer connection.
