
HOSCAR MOSS ROAD, IVY HOUSE FARM, WEST LANCS BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hoscar Moss Road, Ivy House Farm from 20 metres either side of Hoscar Level Crossing
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
1. The prohibition will be operative from 0020 hours to 0530 hours on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
2. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
3. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:- Hoscar Moss Road – Waness Blades Road – Mailns Lane – Ring O Bells Lane – Hoscar Moss Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to Level Crossing annual service works to be carried out by Centurion Traffic Management on behalf of Network Rail.
