
<u>NOTICE OF PROPOSAL</u> ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PRESTON ROAD, LYTHAM ST ANNES, FYLDE BOROUGH) (PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a toucan crossing in the following lengths of road:

- a) Preston Road, Lytham St Annes, from a point 46.8 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Boundary Road for a distance of 37.3 metres in a south westerly direction on the north east bound carriageway;
- b) Preston Road, Lytham St Annes, from a point 38.1 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Boundary Road for a distance of 41 metres in a south westerly direction on the south west bound carriageway.



Statement of Reasons

The proposals are being pursued as part of a Section 278 agreement under the Highways Act 1980. These proposals are being funded fully by the developer and are linked to the new Aldi retail development and associated planning conditions. The purpose of the proposed Toucan crossings is to provide safe crossing point for cyclist and pedestrians to promote sustainable travel and promote social inclusion. The proposal seeks to mitigate against the increase in traffic and pedestrian movements generated by the new development.
