CROW LANE AND FARLEY LANE, UP HOLLAND, WEST LANCS/BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 202

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of highway in the borough of West Lancashire;
 - i Crow Lane, Dalton from its junction with Beacon Lane to its merging with Farley Lane.
 - ii Farley Lane, Up Holland from its merging with Crow Lane to its junction with Roby Mill.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 24th June 2025 to 1700 hours on 26th June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
 - 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
 - 5.An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Roby Mill – Stoney Brow – College Road – Mill Lane – Beacon Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow annual Level Crossing Service works to be carried out by Centurion Traffic Management on behalf of Network Rail.
